Australia's Alternative Technology Association (ATA) has won a major international award for its work bringing solar-powered lighting to remote villages in East Timor. The 72 MW project in Manatuto, developed jointly by Japan's Itochu Corp and France's EDF, will also feature a 36 MW battery energy storage system to ensure stable and. The PV modules are mounted on a large carpark structure.
