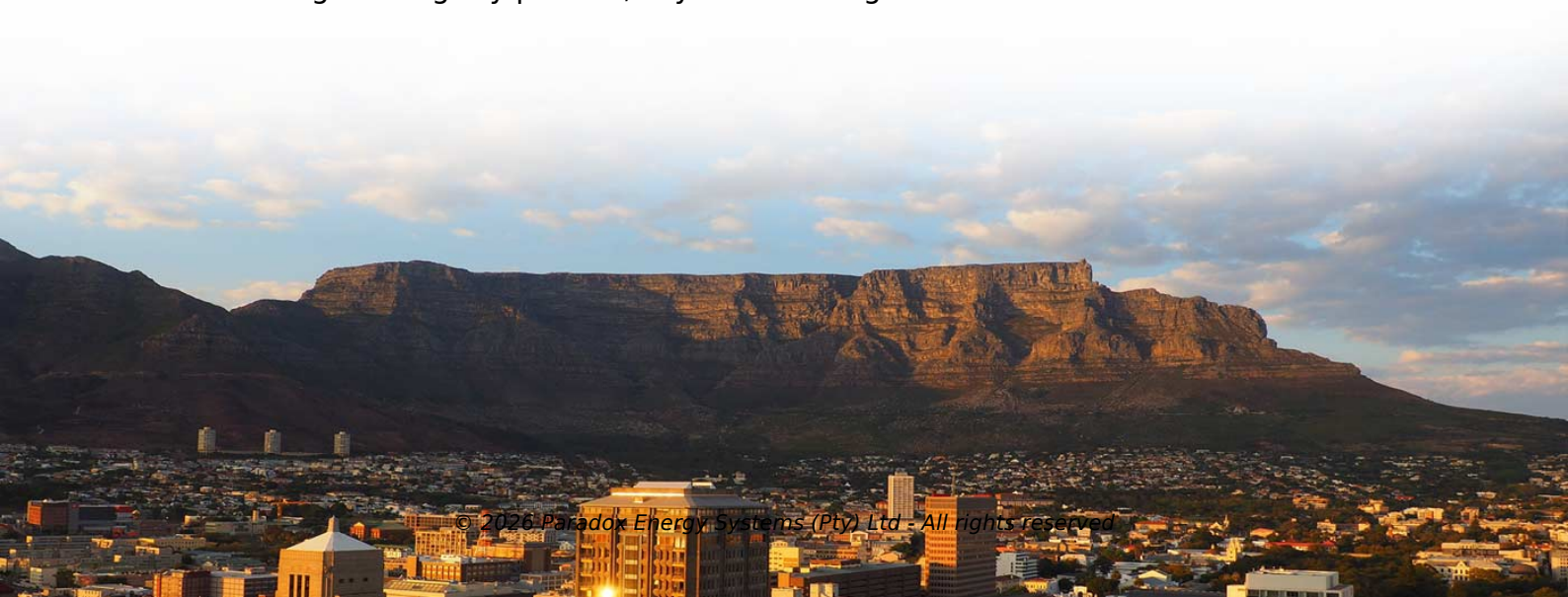


Bogota electricity policy



Overview

The new policies require power generators to sell at least 95% of centrally dispatched hydro output via contracts, and introduce new differentiated capped Scarcity Prices for hydro, coal and renewables (to 359COP/KWh from around 900COP/KWh) versus thermal plants.
