If you consume 100 amps a day, it will take 400 watts of solar power to replenish the generator. Solar generator capacity are usually in watts so calculating the size is straightforward. Daily power usage = solar panel size needed. If you consume 1200 watts a day, a 300W solar panel can recharge a solar power station in 4 to 5 hours.
